

### **Trauma & Acute Care Surgeon**

The Department of Surgery of McMaster University in affiliation with Hamilton Health Sciences is seeking applications from suitable candidates for the position of a Trauma & Acute Care Surgeon within the Division of General Surgery, based at the Hamilton General site. Hamilton General Hospital is a tertiary level trauma centre serving a catchment area of more than 2.5 million residents. The ACS Service supports the emergency department, trauma and inpatient services, and plays an essential role in the support of several other regional programs at the Hamilton General site. The General Surgery, Trauma Service and Acute Care Service, together with the Department of Surgery, McMaster University are involved in undergraduate, post-graduate and continuing medical education programs. This is a full-time faculty position for a period of three years (renewable). Academic rank will be commensurate with the candidate's qualifications and experience.

Applicants must have obtained Fellowship Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or equivalent, and be licensed or eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario. The successful candidate will have completed training in Acute Care Surgery and Trauma. The clinical duties will include duties in Acute Care General Surgery and Trauma Service. The successful candidate will be responsible for managing and promoting best clinical practice within the Acute Care General Surgery Service, and will be expected to show evidence of interpersonal and collaborative skills with initiative to further advance clinical and academic productivity. A commitment and demonstrated interest in surgical education at all levels is essential, as well as active participation in research programs and academic initiatives of the Acute Care Service, Trauma Service, and General Surgery Program. Preference will be given to candidates with Masters level training relevant to academic activities of the Department of Surgery.

Applications must include up-to-date curriculum vitae, and a description of previous academic experience, as well as of specialty training. Applications must be received by April 30, 2017. Applications are to be submitted to
